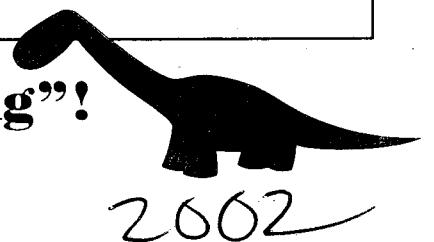
From Northern St. Mary's - Located on Point Lookout Rd (Rt. 5) 1½ miles from intersection of Rts 5 and 235 at WAWA. From Southern St. Mary's - Located on Point Lookout Road (Rt. 5) 10 miles north of Leonardtown

1. You will have plenty of opportunity to study the maze design before entering.
2. There are water and rest stops within the maze.
3. It generally takes about an hour to complete the twists, turns, and dead ends of the maze at a reasonable pace with a short rest stop. (There is a shortcut, however!)
4. Each group will be given a flag as they enter the maze. If you need help exiting the maze, wave your flag **ABOVE** the corn and someone will come and assist you out.
5. Please stay on the trails. Do not cut through the corn.
6. Each ticket holder gets a free prize for completing the maze.
 - A watermelon or pumpkin (in season) or
 - A free snack at our Snack ShackMelons, snacks, and photographs are also available for sale.
7. After your maze walk, you can enjoy a snack at our picnic area, visit our farm animals, play on the hay slide and get a free face painting.

Crazy Corn Maze



- Welcome. Enjoy yourself and stay in the maze for as long as you like. We ask that you stay on the trails and do not cut through the corn.
- There are 3 rest areas with water coolers in the maze. A maze map is posted at each rest area.
- If you are concerned about getting lost, please take a flag with you on your walk. If you need help, raise your flag above the corn and someone will come to assist you out.
- Please feel free to use one of our wagons to pull young children through the maze.
- There are 5 mailboxes in the maze with colored disks in them. Collect all five colors and turn them in at the Snack Shack for your free prize at the end of your maze walk - a melon or pumpkin in

season or a drink and a snack at the
Snack Shack

- Remember to ring the Victory Bell at the end of your maze trip.
- The face painting, hayride, play area and visit with the farm animals are free.
- The fossil dig is 50 cents (each)
- A Souvenir photograph in a jacket is \$1.00 each. Have your picture taken with the corn lady!
- Snacks and farm produce also for sale.
